GUIDE FOR NEW STUDENTS

Welcome to Mid Wales Dance Academy Juniors - we hope you and your child will enjoy being a part of our dance school. We have put together this guide to help you with the information you need when you join.

Classes

If your child is joining the Saturday classes we are happy for you to stay with them for the first session to help settle them in and to see how the class is run. Once they are settled however, we would prefer you to leave them with us, as children are often distracted by parents being in the room and tend to find it hard to concentrate. We hold "parents watching" classes during the year so that you can come and see what your child is achieving.

Uniform

We ask pupils to wear a uniform so that every child feels the same in class, we also use the uniform as a base for costume for our annual show. Also when the children are older, they will need the right uniform when taking examinations. We prefer socks for the Saturday classes rather than tights as it is easier for children if they have to go to the toilet. Please do not send your child in a net tutu skirt - these are not appropriate for our classes. The kit for Saturday classes are available to buy on Saturday mornings, the uniform is also available through our online dance store (link below). For weekday classes and boys uniform please use the link below to order the correct uniform online.

However, please do not feel you have to buy all the uniform straight away. We are happy for you to feel your child has settled into the class first before you buy, and t shirt, leggings, and bare feet/socks are acceptable for the first few sessions.

Please note that ballet shoes are one size larger than outdoor shoe size.

Getting here

All ballet and tap classes are held at Theatr Brycheiniog, Brecon. When you arrive at the theatre, you can park in the main carpark, please be aware that this is pay and display. Please make sure you register your child's attendance each week. This is a safety regulation so that we know who is in the studio in case of evacuation. Also please be aware that the theatre is a public building, and children should not be changing clothes in the foyer. Please use the theatre toilets if necessary. Parents are responsible for their children in the foyer until they are taken into class.

Please take a moment to read through our Child Protection policy and Terms and Conditions as by signing the registration form you are agreeing to their terms.

Attendence and Fees

If your child is going to be absent for more than one week, we would be grateful if you could let us know. In the event that a child is absent for three weeks in a row, unless we hear from you we will assume that you no longer want the place, and will offer it to someone on the waiting list for the next half term. Fees are still payable for that half term.

Fees are payable half termly in advance, and you will be billed before the start of each half term. Payment can be made by cash, bank transfer or card - we no longer accept cheques. Please note that payment for the half term is payable whether your child attends a class or not and no refunds can be given.
